Aprox. 1800 bibles have been purchased since the Bible ministry began almost a year ago. 1500 of these bibles have been distributed. Through the work of God in this ministry, over 1,000 souls have been reunited with Christ! Thank you, Jesus!

Annual tuition, fees, books, and uniform fees are \$5,000 for all 30 kids.

Message from Simon: Thank you for the help with the children's nutrition and balanced diet. No meals are missed and the children are strong and healthy.

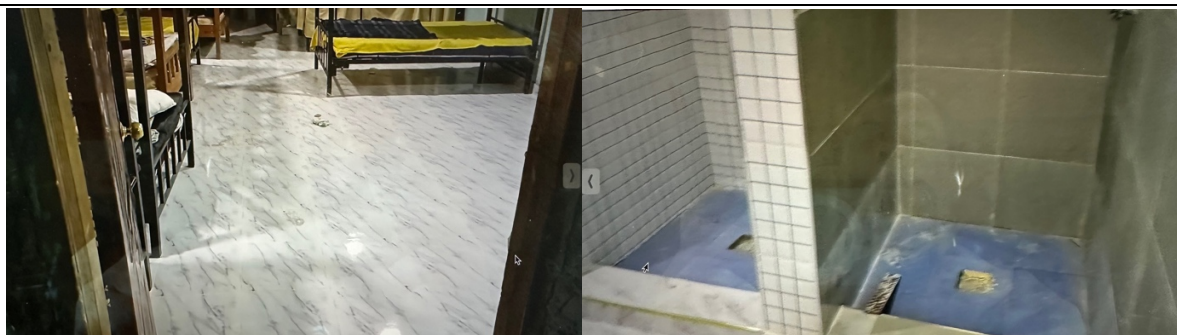
Security Fencing:

Regularly (probably once every 2 weeks), people were climbing the perimeter wall of the Children's Home and gaining access to the property. Recently, in a rush to get inside the house and escape the intruder, Miriam cut her arm on the slide and required stitches. While everyone was inside the home, the man threw rocks at the windows. In November, razor wire and electric lines (with battery backup) were installed at the top of the perimeter wall. Everyone is very thankful for this added security they now have peace and sleep easier.



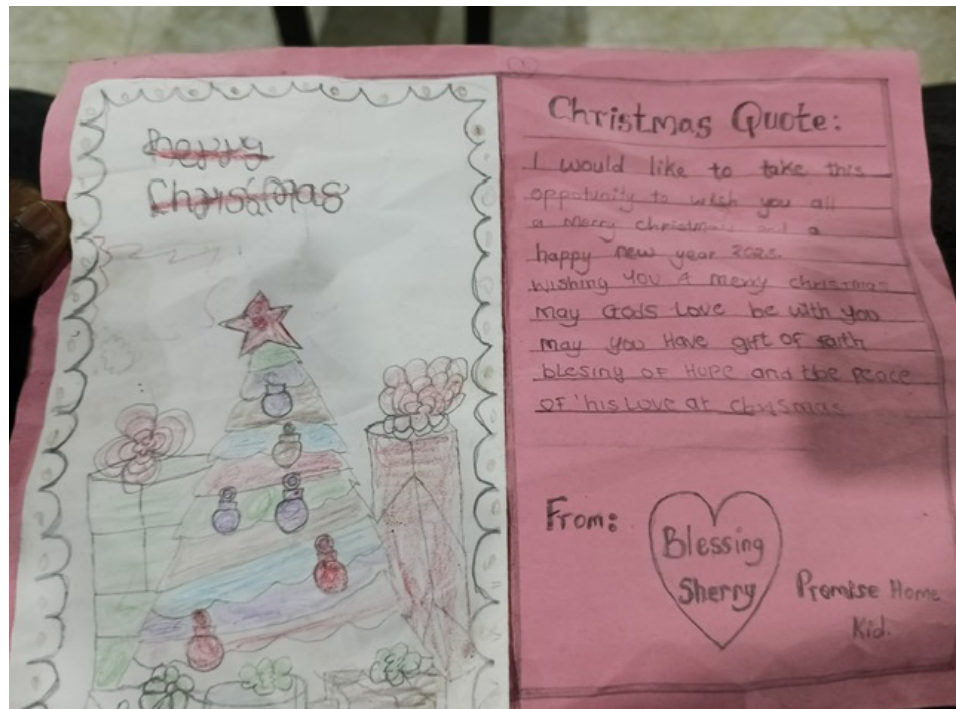
New Tile:

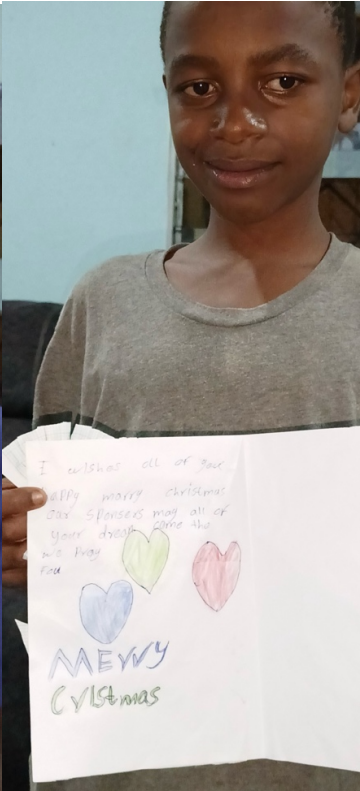


Christmas Card

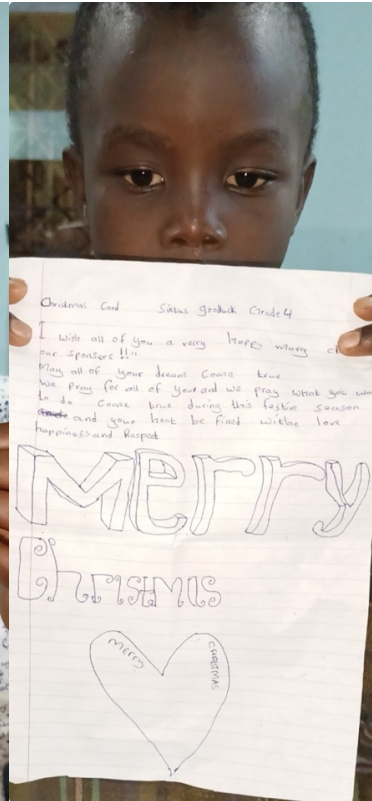

The Result/ The Ministry Christmas Card:



In November, **Redeemed Global Ministries Inc** was officially approved and recognized as a charitable religious **501(c)(3)** organization! This arrived several months ahead of schedule. All donations made previously as well as those going forward are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law. Thank you, Lord for ALL YOU have done.





Car Repair: The car has been having issues throughout the year. It was in need of repair May, June, and July. Received repair in August and was operating ok until December. It is now smoking and overheating. The mechanic has said that it should only be used for short distances... that the engine is bad. Please help us pray over this situation as a car is needed to take children back and forth to school as well as for groceries and emergencies. We would love to be able to buy a van but simply need a vehicle that will work reliably.

Health Insurance:

Another Minor Medical Health Insurance policy is being purchased that will cover an additional 8-9 of the 30 children! Praise God! 1 was previously purchased August 2024 that went into effect September 7th. The existing policy includes Momma Beatrice and 9 children (max allowable). These policies handle medical issues that do not require surgery or hospital care such as flu, malaria, pneumonia as well as the medicine needed for such diagnosis. The cost for each policy is \$450/year. 2 additional policies are needed to include all 30 children.

The following is a list of prayer needs:

1. Pray the church & children's home be a beacon of the Light of Jesus to the region.
2. Pray for protection over the property & health of the children/family.
3. Josephat's business. Josephat (oldest son of Momma Beatrice) opened an electric business. He is an electrician by trade. Pray that his business will be prosperous.
4. Pray for growth within the church and direction as a new church is planted.
5. Pray for the mission teams that will be going to Kenya in 2025 (Feb, May, & Sept). May God work within the hearts of those we serve as well as those serving.
6. We are in need of a milk cow to provide milk to the children's home.
7. We are also in need of another water tank to allow more water storage so that the water well pump does not have to run as often. This will decrease the electric bill.
8. Pray for a reliable vehicle whether our current vehicle be fixed or a different vehicle.

Praise Reports:

1. Jackson (16, diagnosed with sickle cell anemia) is back to having monthly medical checkups! Please continue to pray for his healing. The pain for him is often very difficult.
2. Josephat is out of the hospital & back home after a 2.5 week stay. The meningitis that had traveled into his spinal cord & brain Apr 2024 returned. Thank God for all He has done in Josephat's life. The doctor is acknowledging the power of God in Josephat's life. He says most do not recover from 1 case of meningitis. Josephat has recovered from 2!
3. Three Mission teams are going to Kenya in 2025! Space is still available for you to join!
4. The chickens are almost laying enough eggs to provide for the children's home needs.
5. 1400+ lives reunited with Christ through bible distribution, revivals, and school ministry.
