12 of the 30 children within the children’s home are currently sponsored!



**Year in review:**

1. 3 mission teams served in Kenya: February, May, and August.
2. Over 3,500 Kenyan teenagers heard the gospel message through the school ministry.
3. Close to 1,000 Kenyan students accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior through the school ministry.
4. 790 bibles distributed within the schools and the village.
5. Feminine products distributed within Kenyan schools. Girls often fall behind educationally due to the lack of feminine products.
6. A village crusade was held while the August mission team was in Kenya. This was a great time of serving the community of the children's home, connecting with those in the community, and loving the community. Many were saved. Many were healed.
7. A church plant is underway in Kakamega Kenya. Pray for growth.
8. Village evangelism ministry began this year. What an honor to be invited into a stranger's home, to connect with them, pray with them, and share with them how much God loves them.
9. Many received prayers of healing during village evangelism and the village crusade.
10. One year ago, Josephat, Momma Beatrice's oldest son, was healed of meningitis. Doctors and staff expected him to die but Jesus had other plans. Thank you, Lord! Today, Josephat is operating his own electrical business (he is an electrician). He is sowing back into the children's home and church.
11. Both Walter & Barrack needed surgeries in 2025. We are thankful for their full recovery.
12. In February, Jackson (17) came up to me with a smile on his face and said, "Mike, my pain is gone!" Jackson had been suffering from Sickle Cell Anemia and often experienced severe pain. We are thankful that his medical treatments are working. All honor and praise goes to our Lord Jesus Christ who is the ultimate physician.
